Cefazolin	Production delays	< 3 days	Intermittent small releases starting early Dec. 2018
Diphenhydramine 50mg/ml INJ	Manufacturer shortage.	< 3 days	Pharmacy received a very small shipment last week. Allocated to some service lines. (BMT, ITA)
Fluorescein Sodium Injection: 10% (5mL); 25% (2mL) Ophthalmic Solution: 5mL Ophthalmic strip: 1 mg	Long term backorder status. Severe limitation on production until 2019.	<3 days	Pharmacy aliquoting batch units.
Hydralazine Injectable	Shortage through Q4 2018.	5 days	Consider use of alternates when appropriate.
Labetalol INJ	Production delays	< 5 days	Countermeasure has been decided; SBAR will be sent out shortly.
Lidocaine 1% for inj.	Critical low/stock out of Lidocaine 1% vials (all sizes) No recovery date.	< 2 days	Pain- limit patient selection; Central line starts for Potassium IV - use 1mL of Lidocaine 2%; IV Lidocaine 2% 250 mL- limited supply
Nesiritide 1.5mg INJ	Sole manufacturer is on long term backorder due to API disruption.	None	
Proparacaine 0.5% ophth sol	Supply disruption that resulted to production delays.	<2 days	Next release date is Mid November.
Valsartan Tablets	Due to global recall; all valsartans were pulled out from inventory.	None

Bupivacaine	Production delays through mid-June 2019.	5-7 days	Allocate inventory to PeriOp
Dextrose 50% INJ	Manufacturer shortage; limited releases throughout 2018.	<14 days	Full recovery is late spring 2019.
Dopamine IV vial	Limitation on production through Q4 2018.	<5 days	Premade bags are available.
Doxorubicin 50mg powder INJ	Manufacturer shortage.	< 30 days	Full recovery is Jan 19. (317 vials on hand and will expired 1/31/2019)
Magnesium Sulfate INJ	Manufacturer shortage; limited releases throughout 2018.	<14 days	Vials are not available.
Mepivacaine INJ	Severe limitation production until Q4 2018.	< 3 days	Discussed in bi-weekly Periop Drug Shortage huddles.
Sodium Bicarbonate INJ (SYR)	Manufacturer shortage; limited releases throughout 2018.	< 14 days	ETA late Dec 18. Vials available.
Thrombin 5,000 Units	Allocation until manufacturer can keep up with demand.		Stanford Health Care is on allocation for 300 vials per week.
